



Butts Brow — Jevington



Essential information:

- Total distance: 2.6 miles
- Total ascent: 576 feet
- Start is at Butts Brow car park. A short walk perfect for a Summer's evening or with young children. A pub and a café at Jevington

1. Start: Butts Lane car park (change will be needed) The car park has two main areas. You need the area on the right hand side of the car park as you drive into it from the road. At the back of this area you will see a wide metal barrier gate. The path is just to the right of this gate and leads to a corner of the car park. You will see a walker's gate and a direction post which points down the hill. The walker's gate has a sign indicating "Bridleway" and "Jevington". Follow the path down the hill.
2. After 600 yards you come to a walker's gate. Continue through this gate and pass through another walker's gate about 500 yards further on. Just over 300 yards further on you will see a very wide metal farm gate on your right. Pass by this metal gate following the path which bears slightly to the right.
3. Do not walk through any metal gates. Pass through a walker's gate and the path bears around to the right and approaches Jevington. As you bear right, you will see a path to the left which is a short cut to the return section, missing out Jevington. Take this if you wish to miss Jevington from this walk.
4. Pass through the gate by the white house and walk down the tarmaced road into Jevington. You will arrive at the main road. You will be almost opposite Church Lane and you might like to visit the church just a couple of hundred yards up this road. For the village pub turn right onto the main road. (300 yards)
5. To continue the walk turn left at the main road. After just 50 yards you will see "Eastbourne Lane" on the left which is part of the SDW. Turn left and follow the SDW up the hill. Almost at the top you will see a metal barrier gate and a crossroads. Turn left as soon as you pass the gate and this track will take you back to the car park.
